Mental Disability



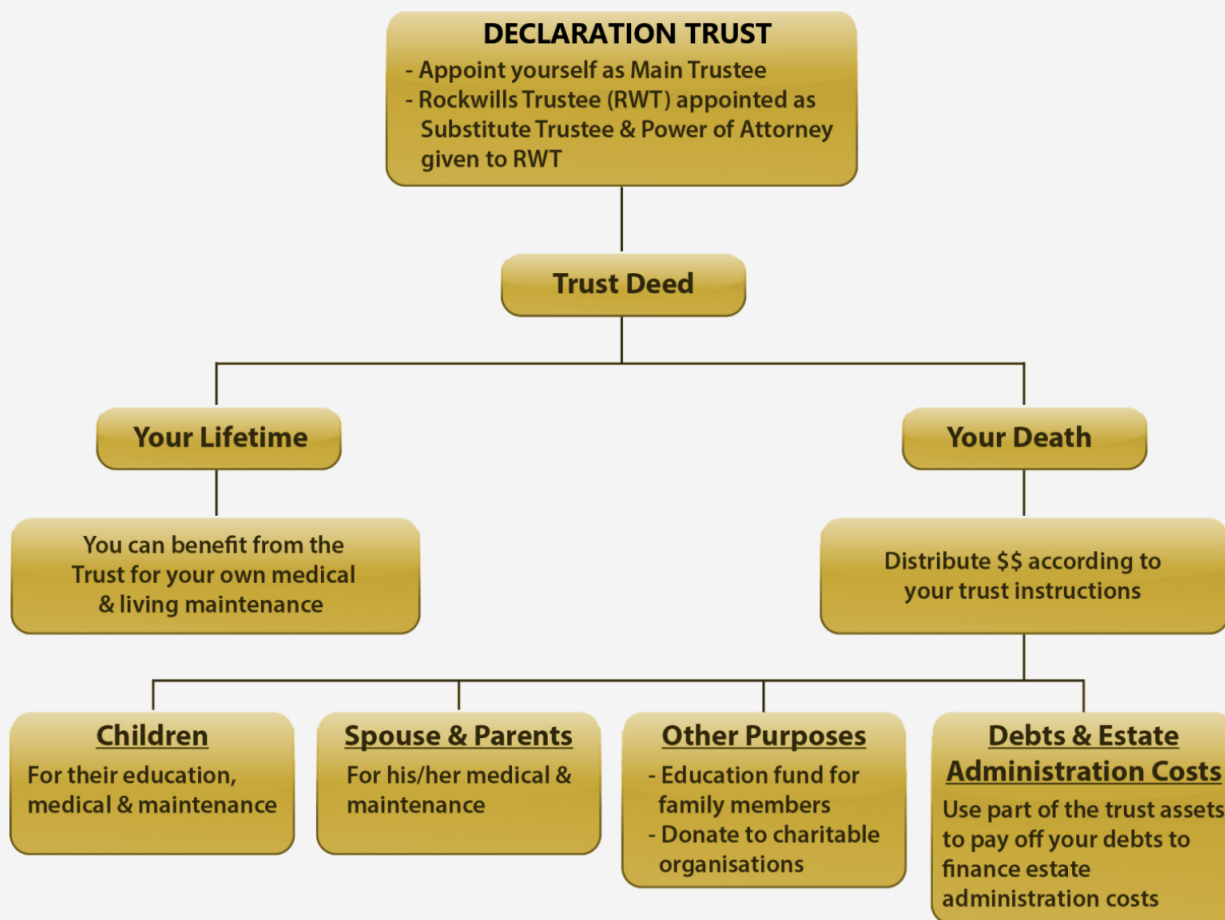
Resignation as trustee



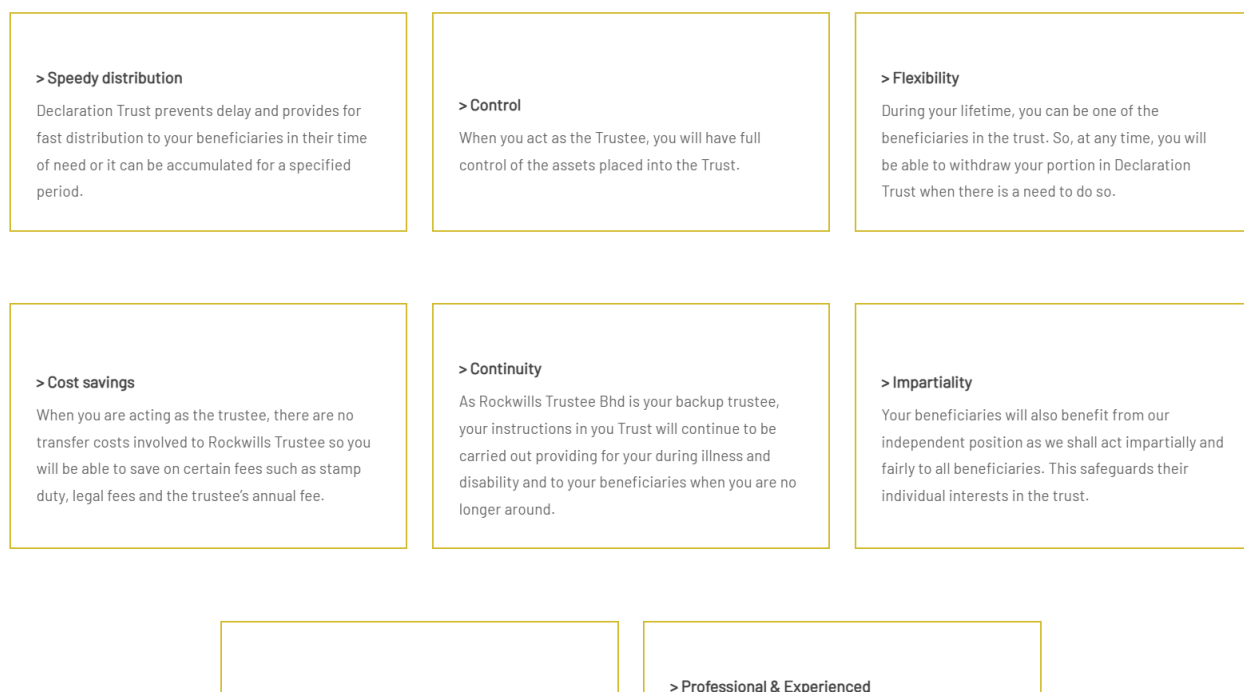
Disappearance for a period of time
